Intellectual Property Agreement

The Attendee hereby agrees to the following:

1. The Attendee agrees to respect and protect all original works of authorship, developments, concepts, designs, drawings, ideas, trademarks, or trade secrets, whether or not patentable or registrable under patent, copyright or similar laws, related to the Company’s business (collectively referred to as “Intellectual Property”).

3. The validity, construction and enforceability of this Agreement shall be governed in all respects by the law. This Agreement may not be amended except in writing signed by the respective Parties.

Refund Policy

For Online Memberships (including yearly virtual sessions, pro memberships), there will be no partial refunds for any yearly membership, and memberships are not transferrable.

For Recordings, there will be no refunds once transaction is completed.

For In-Person classes, courses, workshops, a 100% refund will be issued if cancellation occurs two months before the course date. With less than two months notice and up to one month before the course, those who decide not to cancel will be issued a 50% refund. Less than one month notice, no refund will be issued. Full refunds will be issued in the event that a course, workshop or class is cancelled by the facilitator or host site.

Consideration will be made for special circumstances, on a case by case basis.
